Adolescent Recovery Homes

Hillman House and Marlowe House are long-term residential recovery programs for adolescents ages 14-18. These programs develop independent living skills and provide ongoing support, safety and counseling in a drug-free environment.

Program includes:

- Individual and group counseling
- Family education and counseling
- 12 Step meetings
- 24-hour supervision
- Discharge planning for successful reintegration
- Secondary/higher and vocational education opportunities
- Interpersonal skills training
- Life skills building
- Recreational activities
- Relapse prevention

Admission criteria

- Services are for adolescents 14-18 years of age who have completed a primary substance abuse treatment program
- Admission interview required after inquiry
- Guardian must be responsible for medical and mental health care
- Services are provided without regard to race, religion, national origin or ethnicity
