Project SAFE

Rosecrance is proud to be a Project SAFE (Substance and Alcohol Free Environment) Women's Program treatment provider. For nearly 20 years, Rosecrance has offered one of the largest and most successful Project SAFE programs in the state.

Project SAFE is an intensive outpatient addiction treatment program that is designed to remove many of the common barriers to treatment success for mothers with children.

The Project SAFE program focuses on the impact of addiction on the family. Mothers that could benefit from extra support around childcare, transportation and development of positive parenting skills are appropriate for the program. The ultimate goal is for women to be healthy in recovery, regain custody of their children or end oversight of their families. This program works closely with DCFS and other social service agencies to ensure continuity of care and improved family stability.

Program includes:

- Twelve hours of intensive outpatient addiction treatment services per week, followed by three hours of step-down, continuing care addiction treatment services per week
- A treatment approach that is uniquely tailored to meet the special needs of mothers who are struggling with an addiction problem
- Parenting education and instruction
- Working with caseworkers and mothers to make childcare arrangements to allow for engagement in treatment program
- Assisting mothers and caseworkers in making transportation arrangement of children to childcare and mothers to treatment facility.

Upon successful completion of the program, clients participate in a graduation ceremony to celebrate their accomplishments in recovery.
