### 2000 adults

Rosecrance Lakeview has been a **resource** to over 2000 adults, launching into a life of recovery since 2016.

Rosecrance Lakeview provides young adults and adults with a supportive recovery environment that includes: structured recovery living, individualized recovery plans, outcomes-based programs and outpatient treatment services.

Our unique Launch to Life program provides life and career coaching, guidance in goal setting and personal accountability to help clients grow in their recovery and realize their full potential.

Public health experts say conditions created by the pandemic could hurt the nation's fragile progress in fighting drug related deaths.

The number of **opioid-related deaths** in Cook County has doubled in the first six months of this year compared to the same time period last year.



5.1 million young adults age 18 to 25 battled a **substance use disorder** in 2017, which equates to 14.8% of this population and about 1 in 7.
